



Where to Send Collected Postcards and Stories

Drop the Labels Postcards:

1. Have students fill out postcards provided for you in the DTL packet.
2. If you run out of postcards provided, copy template postcard onto orange cardstock paper. You can also get a copy of the postcard by visiting www.genderyouth.org.
3. Put stamp onto postcards.
4. Representative Shimkus' address is already on the postcard.
5. Hold a "Drop-off" photo shoot, when you put postcards into the mail. Do not forget to take pictures for the GenderYOUTH website!

Share Your Story:

1. Make copies of the "Share Your Story" sheet.
2. Collect "Share Your Story" during tabling and meetings. Explain that GenderYOUTH would like to post stories on-line. If they do not want their story on-line they should not sign the agreement statement.
3. Inform students that they can also fill out a "Share Your Story" on-line by going to www.genderyouth.org.
